Sacramental Preparation

John the Apostle parish has 2 cycles for sacrament preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist. Classes for the 1st cycle are held from August - May with spring sacraments. For the 2nd cycle, classes are held from late February - December with sacraments in November. Placement is made according to application date with preference to returning students of registered St. John the Apostle parishioners. There is a student cap per cycle of 125 students.

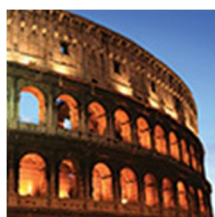
