Scripture Reflection

How much faith do you really have? Do you really believe in all the teachings of the Catholic faith? Can you believe that Scripture is truly the divinely inspired Word of God? Do you really believe in the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist? Do you believe that God has a plan and that each of us plays an important role in that plan?

If we truly believe, Jesus tells us that with the smallest amount of true faith we can do anything. Unfortunately, our human-ness gets in the way. We doubt, we have trouble believing, we need the "proof." In the first reading we hear that all things will come to pass, but not at our time. When we have true faith, we understand that things happen not on our timetable, but on God's.

When we have true faith we place our needs and obstacles in God's hands; we offer up our time, talent and treasure for the good of the Church; we love and forgive one another. We need to pray that God may increase our faith; so that our faith is able to relocate trees or move mountains.

May we experience the true peace of God; may we be filled with faith to follow Jesus; and may the Holy Spirit lead, guide, and enlighten us.

Reflexiones de Escrituras

Cuando tenemos fe verdadera ponemos nuestras necesidades y obstáculos en las manos de Dios; le ofrecemos nuestro tiempo, talento y tesoros por el bien de la Iglesia; amamos y nos perdonamos mutuamente. Necesitamos orar para pedirle a Dios que incremente nuestra fe; para que nuestra fe pueda reubicar árboles y mover montañas.

Ojala podamos experimentar la verdadera paz de Dios; ojala estemos llenos de fe para seguir a Jesús, y ojala que el Espíritu Santo nos lidere, guíe, y nos ilumine.
