In Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship (no. 17), the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us: "The Church equips its members to address political and social questions by helping them to develop a well-formed conscience. Conscience is not something that allows us to justify doing whatever we want, nor is it a mere "feeling" about what we should or should not do. Rather, conscience is the voice of God resounding in the human heart, revealing the truth to us and calling us to do what is good while shunning what is evil." Conscience is a judgment of practical reason that helps us to recognize and seek what is good and to reject what is evil (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1778, 1796).

Baby World: Thank you for all the recent donations we have received. With the cooler weather we have many parents seeking warmer clothing, especially jackets and shoes. If your children have outgrown items from last year, please consider donating them to Baby World to help the families unable to afford suitable clothing.

Numbers for August.... We distributed \$2,777 dollars to clients for utilities, \$2,644 for housing and \$1,710 for pharmacy assistance.

Faith in Action: This week a young mother with 5 children in the home asked for our assistance with her water bill. She was threatened with a gun at her previous job and quit on the spot. The father of her children has not been paying child support and she has a traffic ticket she is unable to pay. We were able to help her with her water bill. But she was more excited because we referred her to a job locator where she has a good chance of finding employment. She left our office excited to speak to the job service and was much more hopeful than when she arrived. This assistance is possible because of the generous parishioners who tithe to our parish.

Scripture Reflection

This weekend we hear from the Book of Kings about a man who was cured by the lord, through the word of Elisha, of his leprosy. He is very grateful to God for his cleansing that he wants to bestow upon Elisha a gift. Elisha understanding the miracle was truly the work of God refuses the man's generosity. The man was so grateful for being cured that he was willing to give a gift or make some sacrifice, for his cure.

In Paul's letter to Timothy, we hear Paul say that he is willing to bear anything to bring salvation to all those who will hear. For the gifts Paul has received, he is willing to sacrifice everything, even his life.

In the Gospel, Jesus cures ten lepers, and only one, a Samaritan (the Israelites and the Samaritans were enemies) returned to thank Jesus for curing him.

When we consider giving back to God, for all our blessings and gifts, what comes to mind? There are many ways of giving back and saying *Thank You* to the Lord for all we have received. Through giving, we offer ourselves in service to God. We become stronger in faith, more aware of others' needs, and we experience the joy of sharing with others in Christ. God rewards those with grateful and generous hearts.
