### Collection Archdiocese for Military Services, USA

Next week our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission, "Serving those who serve" and its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the United States Armed Forces, enrolled in U.S. Military Academics, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs' Medical Centers, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders and the families of these populations, does any other Catholic diocese. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government the AMS receives no funding from government or the military for its programs and services, including the Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program, which provides priests for home dioceses and for the military chaplaincy. La Arquidiócesis de los servicios militares depende únicamente de benefactores privados para apoyar su misión de "servir aquellos que sirven" y su ministerio de proporcionar el mismo cuidado pastoral y servicios a los católicos en el servicio de las fuerzas armadas de los Estados Unidos, a los matriculados en la academias militares de los Estados Unidos, a los que están sometidos a tratamiento médico en cualquiera de los 153 Centros médicos del Departamento de los Veteranos, a los que trabajan en posiciones civiles con el gobierno federal fuera de las fronteras de los Estados Unidos y la familias de estos, tal como lo hacen otras diócesis católicas para sus fieles. Mientras que el gobierno paga los salarios y el plan de retiro de los capellanes castrenses católicos, la Arquidiócesis Castrense de los Estados Unidos de América, no recibe fondos del gobierno o de la militar para sufragar gastos de los programas y servicios, incluso el Programa de Seminarista Copatrocinado, el cual proporciona sacerdotes para las diócesis de origen y la capellanía castrense. **Faith in Action:** This week an immigrant from Africa asked for our assistance. He was working but his car needed repairs. He was told that the repairs would be a couple of hundred of dollars but he was charged \$3,800. He asked the company to take off the items he did not approve but the company said he still owed for the labor to remove them. So he lost his job and cannot get his car back. He has ten- year- old and seven- year- old daughters. His wife is in school in Washington and is not able to help financially. They have an eviction notice and he was frantic looking for assistance. Unfortunately he owed too much for anyone to assist with so he will be evicted. We helped him with an electric bill so if he can get resettled he will not be in default with that company. We gave him resources to help him with housing. Please keep him and his family in your prayers.

**Scripture Reflection**

Our Gospel contains that great story about the tax collector in Jericho, Zacchaeus, who "was short in stature." He was so intrigued by Jesus that he climbed a sycamore tree to get a better view of Jesus. When Jesus saw Zacchaeus and told him he was going to stay at his house, Zacchaeus was immediately inspired to consider things from a different perspective.

If we heard Jesus say to us, "Today I must stay at your house," what would our response be? Anxiety? Fear? Happiness?

At every mass we receive the Eucharist, Christ does come to stay with us. Near the end of his Apostolic Letter, *Mane Nobiscum Domine (Stay with Us Lord)*, Pope John Paul II states, "It is the impulse which the Eucharist gives to the community for a *practical commitment to building a more just and fraternal society.*" In receiving Christ in the Eucharist, it is our duty as Catholics to build community, to uplift one another, to uphold justice.

Zacchaeus knew he had to right his wrongs. He decided to give half of his possessions to the poor and to repay fourfold those whom he had cheated. His practical commitment had real implications for his life. What commitments are we willing to make; what sacrifices for the greater good shall we bear?

Loving God takes commitment, sacrifice and honesty, not only with God, but also to our neighbors and community. What shall you give being a good steward of the blessings God has freely given you?

**Reflexiones de Escrituras**

El evangelio nos habla de la gran historia sobre el cobrador de impuestos en la ciudad de Jericó, llamado Zaqueo, quien "era pequeño de estatura." Él estaba interesado por conocer a Jesús que se trepo en un árbol para poder verlo mejor. Cuando Jesús vio a Zaqueo y le dijo que se quedaría en su casa. Inmediatamente Zaqueo quedo inspirado a considerar las cosas de una perspectiva diferente.

Si escucháramos a Jesús decirnos, "Hoy he de quedarme en tu casa," ¿cuál sería nuestra respuesta? Tendríamos, ¿Ansiedad? ¿Miedo? ¿Alegría?

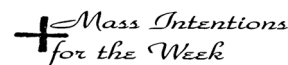
Recibimos la Eucaristía en cada misa, Cristo viene a quedarse con nosotros. Cerca del final de la Carta Apostólica *Mane Nobiscum Domine* (Señor, quédate con nosotros), San Juan Pablo II dice, "se trata de su impulso para *un compromiso activo en la edificación de una sociedad más equitativa y fraterna.*" Al recibir a Cristo en la Eucaristía, es nuestro deber como católicos de construir comunidad, para inspirarnos unos a otros, para resguardar la justicia.

Zaqueo sabía que tenía que arreglar sus errores. El decidió dar la mitad de sus bienes a los pobres y devolver cuatro veces más a aquellos que él les había robado. Su compromiso práctico tuvo verdaderas implicaciones en su vida. ¿Qué compromisos estamos dispuestos hacer, que sacrificios para el bien de los demás debemos de aguantar?

Para amar a Dios nos toma compromiso, sacrificio, y honestidad, no solamente con Dios, pero también con nuestros vecinos y comunidad. ¿Qué debes de dar siendo un buen administrador de las bendiciones que Dios te dio gratuitamente?
